All Residential Buildings to Have Carbon Monoxide and Smoke Alarms by July 1

As per Saskatchewan's Building Code Regulations, every building with residential occupancy is to have carbon monoxide and smoke alarms installed by **July 1**, regardless of when the building was constructed.

Residential occupancies are rented or owned buildings with sleeping quarters such as houses, duplexes, condominiums & townhouses.

2022 Tax Notices have been mailed out. Amounts are due by December 31st, 2022. Payment can be made by cash, cheque, debit or you can pay online through Affinity, Scotiabank or RBC. Any amount owing January 1st, 2023 will be subject to a 10% penalty. Any payments received prior to the following dates will receive a municipal discount: **June 30th: 6% Sept. 30th: 3%**




- ride on the right-hand side of the road

Construction crews are mobilizing to start next week and potentially could be complete in 8 to 10 weeks. The Surveyors have already started their work.

Also, the crews may be in people's ways and they may unfortunately have to block traffic, so we appreciate everyone's patience.
