### Tips to Prepare for the Winter Freeze

- Furnace has been inspected & serviced by a qualified professional during the last 12 mths
- Chimneys and vents have been cleaned and inspected by a qualified professional
- Wood for fireplace / wood stove is dry, seasoned wood
- Fireplace screen is metal or heat-tempered glass, in good condition & secure in its position in front of the fireplace.
- Cover metal container ready to use to dispose cooled ashes (keep 10 feet from the home & buildings)
- Test smoke alarms and make sure they are working. They are needed on every level of the home, inside each sleeping room and outside each separate sleeping area. Best protection, interconnected so when one sounds, they all sound.

Tested carbon monoxide alarms and made sure they are working. Located outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home.

-reflective tape on the back & front of costumes, so drivers can better see your child



- -make/buy costumes in light-colored material
- -use face make up instead of masks so children can see around them.
