




If your clothes catch on fire, stay calm... STOP, DROP and ROLL on the ground while protecting your face with your hands.













Helmet Visor Mask Breathing apparatus Coat **Pants** Gloves -Boots

The firefighter needs special equipment in order to protect themselves against smoke and flames.

They need protective coats, pants, boots, helmet and gloves.
Their suit must be fireproof as well as waterproof.


In order to protect
their lungs against smoke
and fire, the firefighter
needs a breathing
apparatus. That device
is connected to their
mask and sends
them pure air.

Become an inspector in fire prevention. Check this list with your parents and make sure there are no risks for you and your family.

HORIZONTAL LADDERS

- All of the smoke (MSLARA) have been tested by an adult. If they are more than ten years, they need to be replaced.
- The (ERRDY) filter must be clean and clear of all lint.
- When a cooking appliance is used in the (ENTIKCH), the presence of an adult is required.
- Is there a carbon (ONOXMIDE) alarm in the home?
- The (LECRTICE) lines must be in good condition




- Are the (TETBARIES) in the smoke alarm changed? They need to be changed every time we change



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

Is there a carbon monoxide alarm in your house?

Carbon monoxide is an odorless and colorless **TOXIC GAS**. It can come from car mufflers, wood burning stoves, appliances operated with oil, gas or Kerosene.



Preparing an escape plan increases the chances of escaping a fire safely. Everyone must know it! PRACTICE IT with the family and determine a meeting place where you will meet in case of an emergency.




Have the smoke alarm batteries been changed lately?

The batteries have to be changed once a year.

To make sure your smoke alarms are working properly, make sure that they are not older than 10 YEARS, or (based on the manufacturer's recommendations)
