Utility Rate Increase: Due to a rate increase from SaskWater, effective May 1st, the Town of Hague has also had to increase water rates for our customers. The new rates are: \$27.80/1000 gallons minimum and \$27.80/1000 gallons over minimum.

A minimum utility billing will be \$76.30 (includes water, sewer, waste management, recycle fees). The water refilling station token is \$7.75 each.
