### Parking / Snow Clearing:

Trailers, campers and unlicensed vehicles **MUST** be removed from the streets and alleys to enable town personnel to adequately remove snow. As per Bylaw No. 2007-08 no vehicle may be parked at one place for more than 48 consecutive hours.

#### **Extension cords are your own responsibility.**

It is difficult for public works to see the cords while they are blowing snow. Piling snow in the alleys is not allowed due to emergency reasons and preventing spring thaw problems for yourselves and others. Do not pile snow on the streets due to liability issues: obstruction for drivers, attraction of kids to play in dangerous locations!
