### 2015 Garbage Collection Schedule

*Thank you for helping us keep our environment clean and attractive!*

- Ensure your cart is rolled out by 7am on your designated collection day.
- Collection equipment requires clear, safe access to your cart. Do not place your container within 4 feet of buildings, vehicles, overhead and underground utilities; we are not responsible for any damage resulting from service provision
- Containers with inappropriate materials, over weight or overloaded will be bypassed by collection personnel
- Should your scheduled collection day fall on a statutory holiday, please be advised service will continue as normal. If your scheduled collection day fall on either Christmas or New Years Day, collection will occur on the following Saturday.



**Landfill Changes:** Due to changes with Sask Environment as of Jan. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015, residents of the Town of Hague will no longer have access to the RM of Rosthern landfill. We are hoping this will only be a temporary inconvenience. Please contact the town office for options.



**Outstanding Utility Bills:** Just a reminder that all outstanding utility bills from 2014 will be added to the tax roll for property by the end of January 2015. Please ensure your prompt payment.



**Municipal Hall:** Effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014, the rental rates for the Hague Municipal Hall will be \$170 for a full day and \$130 for half a day.



We ask residents to clear a path to their water meters to ensure safe access for our Public Works Dept. to record their readings.

### Parking / Snow Clearing:

Trailers, campers and unlicensed vehicles **MUST** be removed from the streets and alleys to enable town personnel to adequately remove snow. As per Bylaw No. 2007-08 no vehicle may be parked at one place for more than 48 consecutive hours.

***Extension cords are your own responsibility.***

It is difficult for public works to see the cords while they are blowing snow. Piling snow in the alleys is not allowed due to emergency reasons and preventing spring thaw problems for yourselves and others. Do not pile snow on the streets due to liability issues: obstruction for drivers and an attraction for kids to play in dangerous locations!
