Branch Trimming – For the comfort and safety of pedestrians, please trim your tree branches that are hanging

over sidewalks; if not, Public Works Dept will be trimming branches as they see fit.

<u>Reminder:</u> Elm trimming ban is on April 1 to August 31st.

Town personnel will clean-up branches for a fee. Contact the Hague Town Office for details.

Railway Crossing: With welcoming a new business to Town, Frontline Railcar Repair located east of the Carlton Trail Rail line, we are seeing an increase of rail crossing activity. For any questions or concerns about safely crossing tracks, please go to www.railcan.ca. We would also like to remind all pedestrians that crossing the tracks at unmarked locations is <u>VERY DANGEROUS</u> even if it appears that the train is not moving!!!

Unleashed Dogs: Just a reminder, all dogs <u>must be leashed</u> when walking dogs in all areas of town.

Fail to do so may results in 'Running At Large' fines. As per Bylaw# 2001-08, it states that running at large is "...when an animal is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner...and when it is not under control by being: securely confined within an enclosure or securely fastened or leashed so that it cannot roam at will."


