Please be advised that any outstanding taxes from 2015 must be paid in full by the end of June 2016 to avoid further tax enforcement procedures.

### Campers & Trailers:

To accommodate street maintenance as per Bylaw No. 2007-08. "...no person shall park any vehicle at any one place for any period of time exceeding 48 consecutive hours."



Compost is picked up every Monday.  
**Please no wood, branches, pinecones or plastics as they do not decompose.**

Reminder: use bins, bags or boxes.

**Note: Please do not burn garbage in fire pits. The smell is offensive to the neighbors & against SK Environment Regulations!**



**Unleashed Dogs:** Just a reminder, all dogs must be leashed when walking dogs in all areas of town.

Fail to do so may results in 'Running At Large' fines. As per Bylaw# 2001-08, it states that running at large is "...when an animal is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner...and when it is not under control by being: securely confined within an enclosure or securely fastened or leashed so that it cannot roam at will."
