Compost is picked up every Monday.

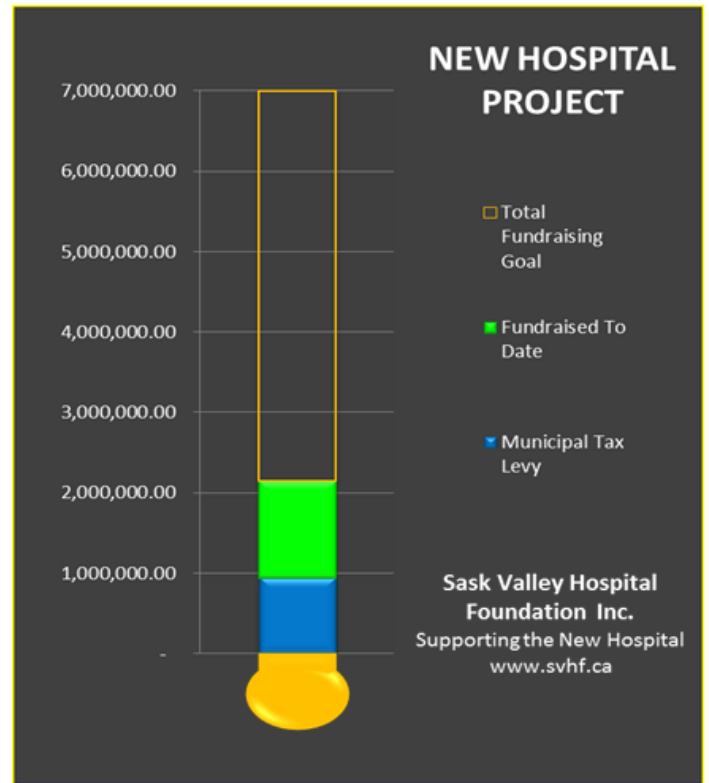
Please no wood, branches, pinecones or plastics as they do not decompose.

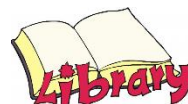
