**Quads-ATV / Dirt Bikes:** With the  
weather turning nice, we'd like reminder that as  
per bylaw: 2007-08 Traffic Bylaw clause 3(k)(4)  
"No person shall drive a mini-bike, or a two, three  
or four wheeled motorized vehicle (All Terrain  
Vehicle) that is not capable of being  
licensed.....on any street, lane, sidewalk, park,  
playground or public reserve, or on any property  
owned or controlled by the Town."



**Utility Rate Increase:** Due to a rate  
increase from SaskWater, effective May 1<sup>st</sup>, the  
Town of Hague has also had to increase water  
rates for our customers. The new rates are:  
\$26.25/1000 gal minimum and \$26.25/1000 gal  
over minimum.

Loraas Disposal Waste Management had  
a rate increase this year bringing the  
waste charges to \$18/month (\$1 increase).



A minimum utility billing will be \$74.75 (includes  
water, sewer, waste management, recycle fees).  
The water refilling station token is \$7.35 each.

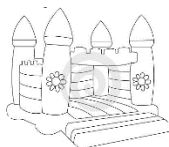

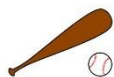


## **Hague Summer Blast** **June 24<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016**

### **Bicycle Safety!!!**



- Always wear a properly fitted helmet!
- Ride on the right side of the road. Stay as far to the right as possible. Use appropriate hand signals and stop at all stop signs.
- Make eye contact with drivers. Bikers should make sure drivers are paying attention and are going to stop before they cross the street or intersection.
- When riding at dusk, dawn or in the evening, be bright and use lights – and make sure your bike has reflectors as well. It's also smart to wear clothes and accessories that have retro-reflective materials to improve biker visibility to motorists.
- Parents, actively supervise children until you're comfortable that they are responsible to ride on their own.
- Drivers, please drive within the designated speed limits, obey all traffic laws, and keep an eye out for bicyclists.
