2014 Outstanding Property Taxes

Please be advised that any outstanding taxes from 2014 must be paid in full by the end of June 2015 to avoid further tax enforcement procedures.



2014 Town of Hague Drinking Water Quality & Compliance Report is now available for consumer review at the Hague Town Office.



Assessment Roll: Town of Hague Assessment Roll is now open for viewing at the Hague Town Office. Appeals will be accepted at the Town Office till the closing 4:30pm on Monday, May 25th, 2015.



Compost is being picked up every Monday .

Please no wood, branches, pinecones or plastics as they do not decompose.

Reminder: use bins, bags or boxes.

Note: Please do not burn garbage in fire pits. The smell is offensive to the neighbors & against SK Environment Regulations!



Recycling: The blue recycling bin located north of the post office is for plastics only!



Fireworks: Just want to remind residents that the Town of Hague has a bylaw restricting individuals from setting off fireworks within the municipality. This bylaw is to address noise and fire safety concerns.



Summer Student: Students between the ages of 15 to 30 interested in summer employment are welcome to inquire at the Town Office. Summer Student Application forms can be found on the town website under Job Opportunity or picked up at the Hague Town Office. Offering a student full-time employment for 8 weeks beginning June 29th.



Water Rate Increase: Due to a rate increase from SaskWater, effective May 1st, the Town of Hague has also had to increase water rates for our customers. The new rates are: \$25/1000 gal minimum and \$25/1000 gal over minimum. A minimum billing will be \$72.50 for 1000 gallons (includes water, sewer, waste management, recycle fees). The water refilling station is \$7.00 per token.

Tips for saving water: **Save A Drop, Save A Lot!**

- Low flow showerhead saves as much as 10L of water per minute.
- Try taking shorter showers. This can save between 6-19L of water per minute.
- Keep a jug of water in the fridge. This eliminates the need to run the tap until it's cold. Saving 7-12L of water per minute.
- Run the dishwasher and washing machine only when they're fully loaded. Each unnecessary load wastes 70-190L of water.
- Your tap uses 7-12L of water per minute while it runs, so turn it off while shaving and brushing your teeth.

Regularly check your faucets, pipes and toilets for leaks. If found, have the leaks fixed as soon as possible to avoid further waste.

Annual Large Items Pick-Up Day will no longer take place due to landfill changes.



Quads-ATV / Dirt Bikes: With the weather turning nice, we'd like reminder that as per bylaw: 2007-08 Traffic Bylaw clause 3(k)(4) "No person shall drive a mini-bike, or a two, three or four wheeled motorized vehicle (All Terrain Vehicle) that is not capable of being licensed.....on any street, lane, sidewalk, park, playground or public reserve, or on any property owned or controlled by the Town."

A Message From Hague First Responders!



With the welcome return of warmer weather, the Town of Hague First Responders would like to remind everyone of some bike safety tips:

- Always wear a properly fitted helmet!
- Ride on the right side of the road. Stay as far to the right as possible. Use appropriate hand signals and stop at all stop signs.
- Make eye contact with drivers. Bikers should make sure drivers are paying attention and are going to stop before they cross the street or intersection.
- When riding at dusk, dawn or in the evening, be bright and use lights – and make sure your bike has reflectors as well. It's also smart to wear clothes and accessories that have retro-reflective materials to improve biker visibility to motorists.
- Parents, actively supervise children until you're comfortable that they are responsible to ride on their own.
- Drivers, please drive within the designated speed limits, obey all traffic laws, and keep an eye out for bicyclists.
