### Building Permits are required for:

New building construction; garage and carports;  
decks; mobile homes; renovations, alterations,  
relocations, demolitions and additions to existing  
buildings; basement development; change of use;  
swimming pools and hot tubs; temporary buildings  
and retaining walls.

Town of Hague Performance Bond Policy states  
that any construction started before a permit has  
been applied for and approved is subject to double  
the permit fee up to an additional \$500. You are  
encouraged to contact the Town Office if you are  
considering any type of construction!

## 10 Tips to Get Ahead of the Winter Freeze *It's not too early to begin preparing for the heating season!*

- Furnace has been inspected and serviced by a qualified professional during the last 12 months
- Chimneys and vents have been cleaned and inspected by a qualified professional
- Wood for fireplace/wood stove is dry, seasoned wood
- Fireplace screen is metal or heat-tempered glass, in good condition & secure in its position in front of the fireplace.
- Cover metal container ready to use to dispose cooled ashes (keep 10 feet from the home & buildings)
- Children stay 3 feet away from fireplace, wood/pellet stove, oil stove or other space heaters
- Portable space heaters have an automatic shut-off and plugged directly into outlet – no extension cords.
- Portable space heaters placed 3 feet from anything that can burn – bedding, paper, walls & even people!
- Test smoke alarms and make sure they are working. They are needed on every level of the home, inside each sleeping room and outside each separate sleeping area. Best protection, interconnected so when one sounds, they all sound.
- Tested carbon monoxide alarms and made sure they are working. Located outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home.
