10 Tips to Get Ahead of the Winter Freeze

It's not too early to begin preparing for the heating season!

- Furnace has been inspected and serviced by a qualified professional during the last 12 months
- Chimneys and vents have been cleaned and inspected by a qualified professional
- Wood for fireplace/wood stove is dry, seasoned wood
- Fireplace screen is metal or heat-tempered glass, in good condition & secure in its position in front of the fireplace.
- Cover metal container ready to use to dispose cooled ashes (keep 10 feet from the home & buildings)
- Children stay 3 feet away from fireplace, wood/pellet stove, oil stove or other space heaters
- Portable space heaters have an automatic shut-off and plugged directly into outlet – no extension cords.
- Portable space heaters placed 3 feet from anything that can burn – bedding, paper, walls & even people!
- Test smoke alarms and make sure they are working. They are needed on every level of the home, inside each sleeping room and outside each separate sleeping area. Best protection, interconnected so when one sounds, they all sound.
- Tested carbon monoxide alarms and made sure they are working. Located outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home.

COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP EVENT

Wednesday, October 5, 8 am to 8 pm

and

Thursday, October 6, 8 am to 4 pm

Anyone bringing items for disposal will be required to present a copy of their latest Town Utility Bill and Identification to correspond to the name on the bill as proof of town residency.

The following items **WILL NOT** be accepted:

Hazardous Materials such as Paint / Solvents / Chemicals / Containers that had contained paints, solvents or chemicals / Batteries / Propane Tanks

Note: Propane tanks can be disposed of at any Saskatoon Co-op Gas Bar Locations;

Creosote Treated Material such as Railway Ties / Power Poles;

Additional Items such as Tires / Wires / Concrete.

The following items will have surcharges at the time of drop off:

- White Goods: \$35 (includes washer, dryer, water heater, stove, dish washer, furnace);
- Fridge / Freezer / Air Conditioner: \$130

If you require the Town to pick up your items from your residence, please call ahead to make arrangements at the Town Office.

This service will be provided for an additional \$10 per trip.
