Building Permits are required for:

New building construction; garage and carports; decks; mobile homes; renovations, alterations, relocations, demolitions and additions to existing buildings; basement development; change of use; swimming pools and hot tubs; temporary buildings and retaining walls.

Town of Hague Performance Bond Policy states that any construction started before a permit has been applied for and approved is subject to double the permit fee up to an additional \$500. You are encouraged to contact the Town Office if you are considering any type of construction!

Are You Prepared?

With Fall coming upon us, the Government of Saskatchewan would like to remind everyone of some basic tips to help ensure the safety of all residents this season. Whether you are hunting, fishing, or simply want to enjoy the changing scenery, remember to check the weather, make a trip plan and carry the ten essentials listed below.

No one every expects to get into trouble outdoors and turn in the weather, mistake in judgment, unexpected injury, or equipment failure can quickly change any recreational outing into a crisis situation. *How prepared are you?*

Taking the Essentials:

- Flashlight
- Fire Making Kit
- Signaling Device (ex: whistle)
- Extra food & water including can opener
- Extra clothing
- Navigational/communication devices
- First Aid Kit
- Emergency Blanket / Shelter
- Pocket Knife
- Sun Protection

Always leave your trip plan with a responsible party, family member or friend. They can notify authorities if you don't return in a timely manner.

No matter how much you prepare, distress situations can still occur. Following these basis tips can ensure a safe, trouble free outdoor adventure for you, your friends and family.
