Hague Town Office will be closed for Labour Day on Monday, September 4th.

Attention Hague Residents: The Town of Hague is the recipient of funds through the Clean Water and Wastewater (CWWF) program for water line upgrades. It will be required to shut off water valves in select areas of Town at select times. Please expect water disruptions and Precautionary Boil Water Advisories during the next month or two. To avoid inconvenience, it is recommended to have a supply of bottled water in your household. If at all possible, we will try to provide a days' notice by email indicating which blocks will be affected. Each water disruption will result in an average of three days of a Precautionary Boil Water Advisory. Each household and business will receive a hand delivered letter (taped to your door) at the onset of an advisory and a subsequent letter at the end of the advisory.

Thank you in advance, for your patience during this time. This project is a benefit for you, our residents and will make our Town a better place to live!



Tree Trimming: For pedestrian comfort and safety, we ask that any branches that hang over the sidewalk be trimmed back. For any branches not trimmed, in due time, the Public Works will be trimming as they see fit.

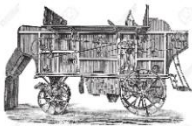

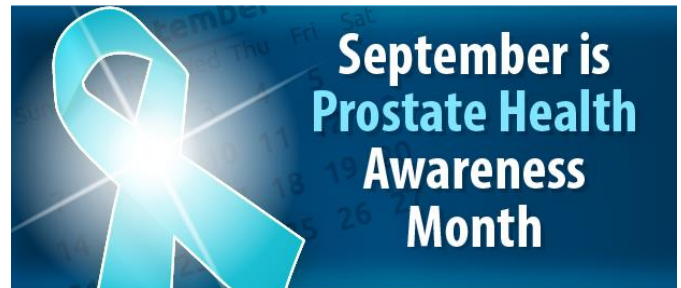
