Dear Waterworks Owner/Operator:

This letter is to advise you that a Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA), has been placed on the Town of Hague's distribution system (affecting the 100 and 200 Blocks of Fourth St. only), and is effective Wednesday September 6, 2017 at 10:00 a.m.

The Water Security Agency's protocol is to place systems under a PDWA if they experience a depressurization of the waterworks system until such a time as their entire system is proven safe for human consumptive use. This Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory is due to planned system maintenance resulting in a depressurization of a portion of the Town of Hague's distribution system, and remains in effect until the safety of the Town of Hague's distribution system, in the affected area, can be ensured to be safe at all times. Therefore, I ask that the administration notify all users of the drinking water distribution system of the conditions in the attached Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory.

This advisory can be rescinded following:

- 1) The repair work has been completed, and the system re-pressurized.
- 2) The distribution system is disinfected and flushed according to applicable standards.
- 3) The receipt of two (2) consecutive sets of two (2) bacteriological samples, along with chlorine and turbidity results, collected one day apart, and marked as "other", that are negative for bacteriological growth in the final treated potable water being supplied throughout the distribution system mentioned above.
