PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT
TO INTRODUCE THE ZONING BYLAW

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Hague intends to adopt a new Zoning Bylaw, No. 2018-01, under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.

INTENT OF ZONING BYLAW

The proposed Zoning Bylaw repeals and replaces Bylaw No. 2013-06 to consolidate amendments, clean up clerical errors, remove imperial measurements, provide clarity throughout the document, address dwelling groups in R2 districts and consolidate the zoning map. The Zoning Bylaw provides regulations and standards for the health, safety and general welfare of the Town of Hague. The Zoning bylaw establishes Zoning Districts that regulate land use and development permitting processes and standards within Town boundaries.

AFFECTED LANDS

All lands within the corporate limits of the Town of Hague are affected by the new Zoning Bylaw.

PUBLIC INSPECTION

Any person may inspect the Zoning Bylaw and Zoning District Map during regular business hours at the Town office or the Town website at townofhague.com. Copies of the Zoning Bylaw are available at cost.

PUBLIC HEARING

The Public Hearing shall be held on July 10, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. at the Hague Town Office (206 Main Street) to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed bylaw. Council will also consider written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the Town Office before the hearing.
