Once it Snows, remember...

Sidewalks and extension cords are your own responsibility!

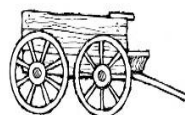
- Please keep your sidewalk clear of snow & ice. This helps pedestrians, especially small children, walk to school and throughout town. Public Works will try to clear sidewalk snow when priority tasks have been completed.
- Extension cords must not be laying on sidewalks and/or covered with snow. It is difficult for public works to see the cords while they are out blowing snow.
- Please clear a path to your water meter to ensure our Public Works is able to safely access your reading to provide accurate billing information.
- Piling snow in the alleys is not allowed due to emergency reasons and preventing spring thaw problems for yourselves and others.
- Do not place snow on the streets due to liability issues: obstruction for drivers and/or attraction for kids to play in dangerous locations!
- **To ensure road snow can be cleared, please remove campers, trailers & unlicensed vehicles from the street.**
